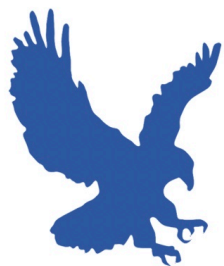
## Meet your Oakland Eagle Boosters 2019-2010 Board
